

Troop 225 Uniform Guidelines

Is it important that a Scout wear his uniform with pride and that it be worn correctly. Here are some guidelines to help him get his Scout uniform in proper order!



Red shoulder loops go on the epaulets.

Patrol patch when it's assigned.

The World Scouting patch goes half way between your pocket and the epaulets.

Wear only Boy Scout service pins. You'll get your first one after one year.

If you earned the religious knot, wear it here.

Scarf and (any) tie slide are required.

The Arrow of Light is the only part of your Webelos uniform that goes on your Boy Scout uniform.

Wear a Boy Scout belt, either the green BSA belt or another Boy Scout belt. On the left or right wear your bead fob for your coups (beads). Your Knothead rope goes on your belt too.

Scout pants or scout shorts are preferred by BSA. Troop 225 allows jeans. Prohibited are: sweats, soccer shorts, camouflage or colored pants or shorts (including khaki), etc. Please NEVER wear any type of synthetic material on campouts.

Apply 225 below the Heart of America Council patch. Badges of office (like Patrol Leader) go below that.

The uniform above is called Class A by our Troop. At times we will wear Class A Dress (like Courts of Honor or Scout Sunday). To do this, add your Merit Badge sash, and if you have them, uniform pants or shorts. Shirts are always tucked in.
