

Suggested Equipment for Summer Campouts

Scout Book: There will be a lot of opportunities for us to sign off on advancements, additionally; it is **“The single most important piece of scouting equipment you own”**.

Change of clothes: Nylon pants are more flammable than other materials. Do not bring them. If you do wear Nylon you will **NOT** be around any fire. Note that we are camping on farmland, and sometimes the weeds are quite high, so longer pants are recommended.

Sleeping bag: If you do not have a sleeping bag, let Mr. Davey or Mr. Knott know ahead of time and we will make temporary provisions for you. There are several inexpensive choices here.

Mattress pad &/or pillow: This is optional, but it can make your night more enjoyable.

Flashlight: We do provide lanterns, however they are extinguished when we go to bed, should you need to get up in the middle of the night, a flashlight is a good thing.

Rain Gear: A good thing to have on any campout. Even if it doesn't rain it can provide an extra layer if the temperature should drop.

Medications: If you require any special medicines, please remember to bring them with you and advise Mr. Davey or Mr. Knott. We can handle meds that need to be refrigerated if you let us know ahead of time.

Bug Dope and Sun Screen: Per B.S.A. regulations these cannot be of the aerosol variety.

Class A Uniform: Boys while in transit to and from campouts must wear it, per B.S.A. regulations.

Cap, Hat, or Bandana: optional but can be helpful on a sunny day. You might consider high-SPF sunscreen.

Pocket Knives: knives are to be carried and used **ONLY** after the Totin' Chip is earned. It may be packed in case the boys have completed or do complete these requirements. If it's out before earning the Totin' Chip or being used improperly it will be taken away, possibly along with the Totin' Chip.
